

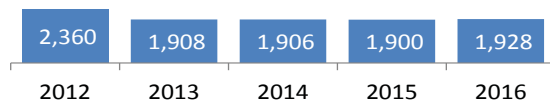

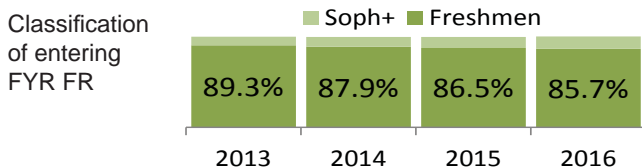


Five-Year Fall Enrollment



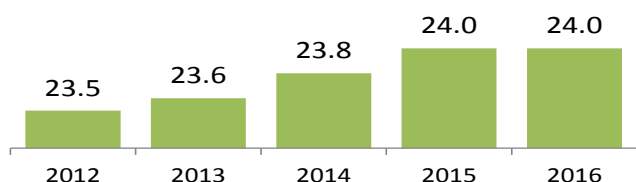
