Re: EHD Faculty Awards Program

I am initiating a new awards program to recognize outstanding work by a faculty in the following three areas:

Scholarship
Use of Technology
Graduate Student Mentoring

The purpose of this awards program is to draw attention to the excellent work being completed all the time by faculty in the college, and to celebrate annually with those who have made a difference in their professions, departments, the college, and the lives of students.

The criteria for each award follows:

Scholarship Award

Any full-time faculty at the rank of Instructor or above is eligible for nomination for this award. Nominees must have a record of scholarly publications and or presentations, and must be actively engaged in research activities at the present time. Nominations can come from faculty (including self-nominations) or from students in CEHD.

Technology Award

Any full-time faculty at the rank of Instructor or above is eligible for nomination for this award. Nominees must have a record of using technology in an innovative or particularly effective fashion in the classroom, in research, or in a professional service aspect of their work in CEHD. Nominations can come from faculty (including self-nominations) or from students in CEHD.

Graduate Student Mentoring Award

Any full-time faculty who is an Associate or Full member of the Graduate Faculty is eligible for nomination for this award. Nominees must have a record of active interaction with graduate students, whether that be in classroom, advising, research supervision, or professional development mentoring activities. Nominations can come from faculty (including self-nominations) or from graduate students in CEHD.

Call for Nominations

Outstanding Achievement in Scholarship by an Individual Faculty Member

College of Education and Human Development

This is the inaugural year of a new CEHD program being implemented to recognize the scholarly work of our faculty. Nominations can be made by faculty or student members of the college.

The nomination **must** include the following:

- A letter from the nominator(s) that outlines the scholarly and or research achievements of the nominee – limit to 2 pages
- A copy of the nominee's curriculum vita
- Letters of support for the nomination from the Chair of the nominee's department
In the event that the nominee is department Chair, submit a letter from a tenured colleague in the department.

Other materials that **may** be included:

- Additional letters of support (from colleagues, students, or other university personnel)
- Up to three samples of current or recent scholarly works

Nominations are **due** by 4:00 pm, **Friday, March 30**. Submit 1 hard-copy **and** an electronic copy to Cindy Juntunen at cl.juntunen@und.edu, and at EHD, Stop 7189, Education 101E.

The award will be announced at the Spring College Meeting on Friday, April 13.

The recipient of the award will receive a plaque and a financial award of \$500, funded by the EHD Research and Graduate Education office.

Outstanding Achievement in Use of Technology by an Individual Faculty Member

College of Education and Human Development

This is the inaugural year of a new CEHD program being implemented to recognize the increasing importance of the effective use of technology across the domains of teaching, research, and service. Nominations can be made by faculty or student members of the college.

The nomination **must** include the following:

- A letter from the nominator(s) that outlines the outstanding use of technology and related achievements of the nominee – limit to 2 pages
- A copy of the nominee's curriculum vita
- Letters of support for the nomination from the Chair of the nominee's department
In the event that the nominee is department Chair, submit a letter from a tenured colleague in the department.

Other materials that **may** be included:

- Additional letters of support (from colleagues, students, or other university personnel)
- Up to three examples of innovative or notable applications of technology

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Call for Nominations

Outstanding Achievement in Graduate Student Mentoring by an Individual Faculty Member

College of Education and Human Development

This is the inaugural year of a new CEHD program being implemented to recognize faculty who provide exceptional support to graduate students, through the supervision of research and or professional development, through advising, through classroom instruction, or some combination thereof. Nominations can be made by faculty or graduate student members of the college.

The nomination **must** include the following:

- A letter from the nominator(s) that outlines the outstanding work of the nominee inside and or outside of the classroom – limit to 2 pages
- A copy of the nominee's curriculum vita
- Letters of support for the nomination from the Chair of the nominee's department
In the event that the nominee is department Chair, submit a letter from a tenured colleague in the department.

Other materials that **may** be included:

- Additional letters of support (from colleagues, students, graduates, or other university personnel)
- Examples of projects or activities completed by faculty-student teams that provide evidence of mentoring activity

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
